








Plain Text vs +ve Emojis vs -ve Emojis








Plutchik's Wheel of Emotions


Annotation Process

- Each final rating is an average of 9 human ratings
 - Consistent set of 9 human annotators
 - Native/near-native speakers of English, age 25–35
 - Extensive prior experience in using emojis for communication
- Annotation Setup
 - Raters were asked to do one set of 25 emojis per day
 - The order of emojis was randomized for each rater

Overall Inter-Annotator Agreement




Correlation between Rater & Gold Scores


